For example two 9 stone juniors are more likely to be allowed to do this than two 15 stone adults who could use a heavier boat with less difficulty. A reasonable level of competence portaging on the canal at Worcester would be expected.	These boats should be the first boats used by those with developing their skills. 1. Crews without access to a boat of their own of a similar standard will take precedence over those with their own boat. 2. All junior crews of a suitable level of competence 3. Junior / Senior mixed crews with a suitable level of competence 4. Senior crews with a suitable level of competence. 5. At sprint Regatta's the Sprint racing Captain will decide who should paddle these boats in the case of race clashes taking into account the advice above. 6. At marathon races the marathon racing captain will decide who should paddle these boats in the case of race clashes taking into account the advice above. It will not necessarily be first come first served. Although last minute decisions to paddle will not help your case!

Permission should be sought from a committee member or coach prior to every use and the use recorded in the bookings book. Only to be used by those who have good stability. These boats are not for learning to balance a boat in, nor for learning to portage with. They are to be treated with great care: washed out and dried after each use and stored in their boat bags with seats kept in the boat inside the boat bag. The sprint racing captain will ensure that suitable weights are available for use with these boats at Nottingham and these are the only weights that should be used . not pebbles , bits of rock etc.)
